Terra Nova is a standardized test used nationwide. Below are the percentile scores for each St. Paul grade level tested from the 2019 test.





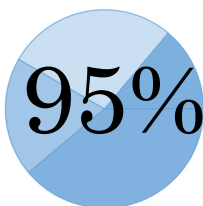

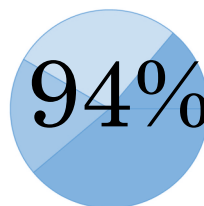
ACRE

ACRE (Assessment of Catechesis/Religious Education) is a standardized test taken in 5th grade and 8th grade across the nation to test Catholic faith knowledge.

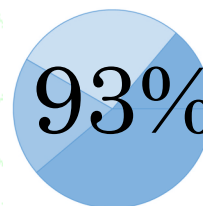

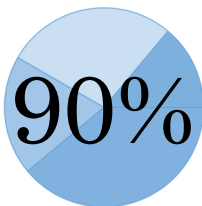

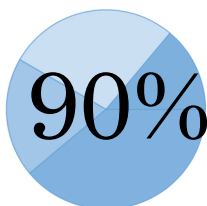
Six thousand square feet of learning space dedicated to 21st Century learning in science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics (STEAM) was added in 2017.

This included an Innovative Design, Engineering, and Arts (IDEA) LAB that serves as an innovative space for problem-solving, creative thinking, and collaboration.

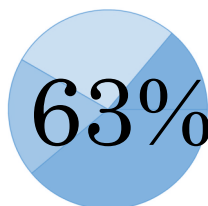
